Rules and Regulations

## 1. Character and purpose of the competition

International Police Rally is a tourist and sport event for enthusiasts of motor sport. The purpose is to bring the athletes of motor sport of all nations together, to enable them to exchange their ideas during the event and to enhance friendship and appreciation to one another across nations.

## 2. Organizer of the competition

According to the resolution by the IPMC Delegate Congress in 2007 in Erfurt / Germany the 64th International Police Rally will take place August 3<sup>rd</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> in 2010 in Debrecen / Hungary.

## 3. Participants

The following groups are entitled to participate: Members of the police force, gendarmerie, customs, frontier police and officials of administration of justice, military police and all members of the sport clubs of the above mentioned organizations.

The above specifications do not exclude participation of representatives of other institutions bearing some other name but performing similar tasks as their official duties. Every enrolled drivers, co-driver and accompanying persons will be treated as participants.

## 4. Documents and Vehicles

Each driver must possess vehicle documents and driving license valid in Germany and the obligatory international insurance. All two-, three-, and four-wheel vehicles with engines admissible on public roads will be admitted.

## 5. Identification Marks of Vehicles

Throughout the whole event each vehicle has to be marked with the starting number provided by the organizer. The number on every vehicle has to be visible clearly. Cars and Buses have to be marked at front and rear, so that it is easily seen.

## 6. Enrolment, registration fee, and additional fees

Each participant of the rally (driver, co-driver and accompanying person) is required to enroll personally. Each enrolment form prepared by the organizer has to be filled completely, legibly and correctly and has to be sent to the organizer before **May/31/2010** at the latest, together with the transfer of the registration fee. You also will be able to register by E-Mail. By March 2010 download the enrolment papers from our homepage and return the completed forms back via e-mail.

Registration fees will be charged to each individual person, except teams. The participants will pay bank charges. Registrations received later than **May, 31st, 2010** will be charged with a late fee of 10.-- Euro per registration. In case of withdrawal registration fees are not refundable.

All the fees mentioned above apply to an individual person except the enrolment for the team.

## 7. Start and finish

As a confirmation of individual enrolment each participant will receive from the organizing committee a starting card that should state the starting place (town and country where the sporting club resides). This has to be confirmed by an official stamp from an appropriate organization or competent club. Finishing line will be the parking lot at Fönix Hall at Kassai út 28. in Debrecen. Directions in Debrecen will be given. Just follow the IPMC arrows.

Opening of the finishing line:

August 3rd, 2010 from 09:00 am until 04:00 pm.

Prolonged opening time at the finishing line: 5:00 pm.

## 8. Classifications

Participants arriving at the finishing line on August 3rd, 2010 later than 4:00 pm score 2 penalty points for each minute of delay. Participants arriving later than 5:00 pm will not be classified.

a) Individual distance-classification

Distant-Classification of each participant arriving at the finishing line within the fixed time limit will be made individually according to the following rules.

The direct distance from the starting place to the finishing line is measured in kilometers. For each kilometer you will be granted 1 point. The direct distance will be based on the official ADAC Tour Planner or the Falk Routen Planner. The starting card has to be turned in personally.

If as the result of classification more than 3 participants score equal points, decision will be made by drawing lots.

Additional points for Individual Distant-Classification:

- Driver and co-driver arriving in a car 5 points each
- Accompanying person in a car 2 points each
- Driver and co-driver on a motorbike 6 points each
- Accompanying person on a motorbike 3 points each
- Bus driver 1 point
- Accompanying person in a bus 1 point each
- Uniform or a club coat or motorbike driver and co-driver in Motorbike dress 5 points

b) Team Distance-Classification

The base of this classification will be the number and points of the individual participants of the team that arrived in person. Starting cards must be handed in personally. Any points achieved in the individual classification will be added to the team classification.

Each club or organization is able to enroll 2 teams in total. In such case one of the teams must belong to the category of 'cars / buses' and the other to the category of 'motorbikes'. Each team must pay a registration fee.

'Cars / buses' category

- Category A: 3 - 5 participants
- Category B: 6 - 10 participants
- Category C: 11 - 20 participants
- Category D: 21 - 35 participants
- Category E: 36 and more participants.

'Motorbikes' category

- Category F: 3 - 5 participants
- Category G: 6 - 10 participants
- Category H: 11 and more participants.

C) Special sport-motor test: 4th Run for the 6th IPMC-European Championship

This special sport-motor test is sport slalom for cars and a skilful tournament for motorbikes. Points scored in this test will be counted for the 6th IPMC-European Championship. The competition will be carried out with vehicles provided by the organizer. Enrolments after the fixed date and any changes of enrolments are not possible according to an IPMC resolution. All participants of motorbikes competition must wear their own protective clothing.

All participants of the sport-motor test holding a valid license are entitled except members of the organizer's club.

Participants of this competition must fill in the register cards for IPMC European Championship in the specific discipline and send it to the IPMC sport commissioner Mr. Christian Rosner as well to the organizer by May, 31st, 2010.

9. Award Ceremony

The award ceremonies will be held on the following days:

- a) 64th International Police Star Rally on August 3rd, 2010 as part of the opening ceremony.
- b) 4th Run of the 6th IPMC European Championship on August 6th 2010 as part of the closing ceremony.

10. Delegates

Each club and organization participating in the rally is able to delegate appointed persons according to the following rules:

- For 5 - 15 enrolled and attending participants: 1 delegate
  - For 16 - 30 enrolled and attending participants: 2 delegates
  - For more than 30 enrolled and attending participants: 3 delegates
- Each nationality should be represented by at least one delegate.

**All delegates must be named to the secretary of IPMC, sekretar@ipmc.org as well as the organizer before by May, 31st, 2010 by using the included form.**

According to IPMC statute, article 12, only those delegates notified to the organizer will be admitted to the 64th IPMC Congress. The Congress will take place on August 5th, 2010 at 9:00 am at KÖLCESEY Convention Centre (4026 Debrecen, Hunyadi utca 1-3)

11. Driving discipline

The supreme duty for every participant of the police Rally Strict is to follow the traffic rules and regulations and offer help to others in emergency situations.

12. Responsibility

All participants and guests of the 61st International Police Rally responsible for themselves in all respects. Organizers and people involved in organizing the rally are not responsible for personal or material damages suffered before, during or after the International Police Rally.

13. Court and conciliation

IPMC Court of conciliation was elected in 2008 at the Delegate Congress in Graz / Austria. Name of those members will be displayed at the finishing line.

14. Clothing

Participants of the rally are requested to wear their uniforms (no weapons allowed) at the time of arrival and during the official events.

### 15. Accommodation / Camp

Reservations at a campsite close by have to be made at the participant's own responsibility until May, 31st, 2010.

### 16. Catering

The participants are expected to take care of their basic catering needs on their own.

### 17. Excursions

All tours start and end at the parking lot at Főnix Hall, in Debrecen.

### 18. Reservation

Table reservations shall be granted on the basis of the chronological order of receiving the registration entries from the individual points of service, clubs, and associations.

### 19. Rights for organizational committee

The organizer reserves the right to make changes to the rules or to supplement it with other regulations, which will become part of these rules. Participants of the rally must obey the rules and regulations related to the rally from the moment they submit their enrolment forms.
